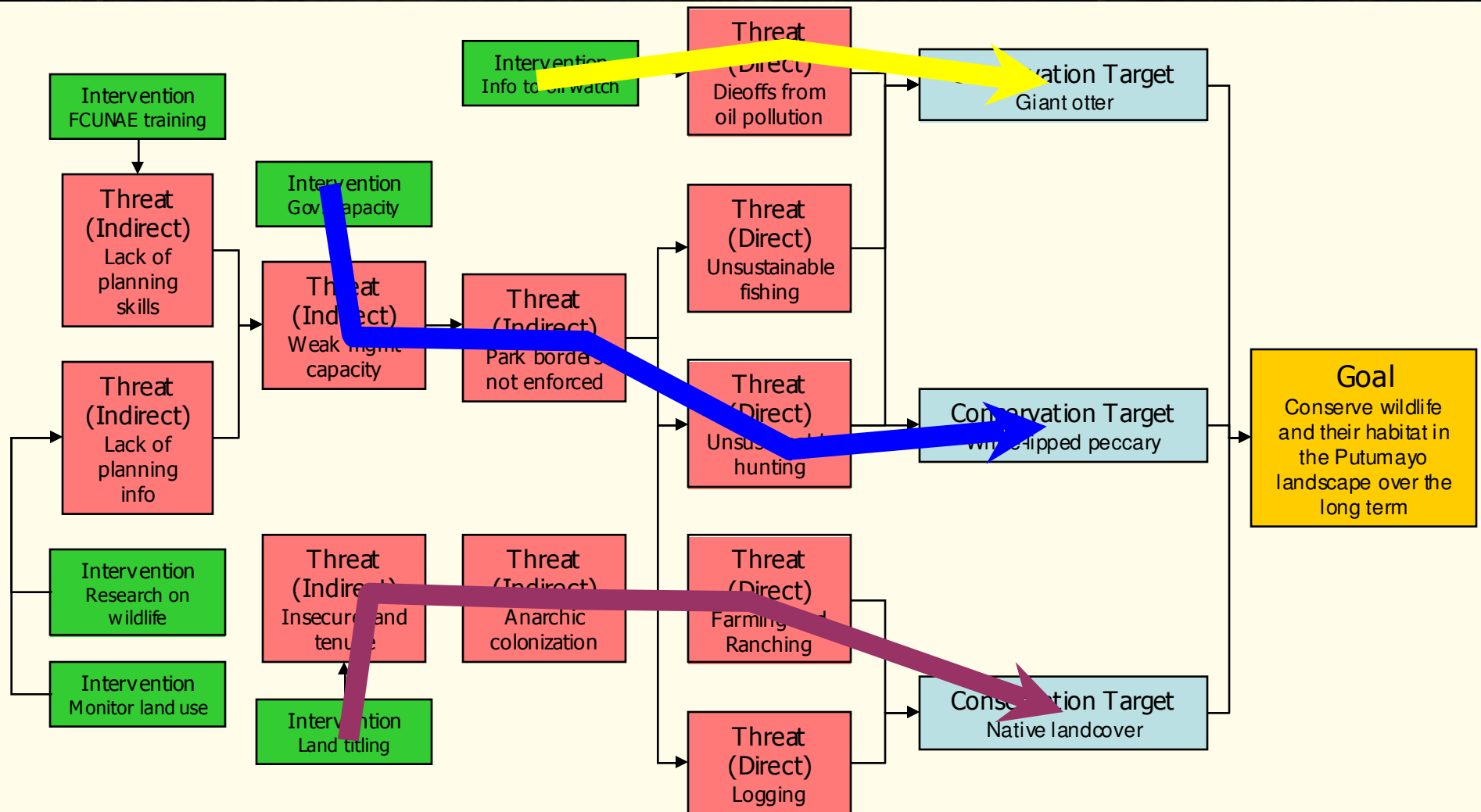

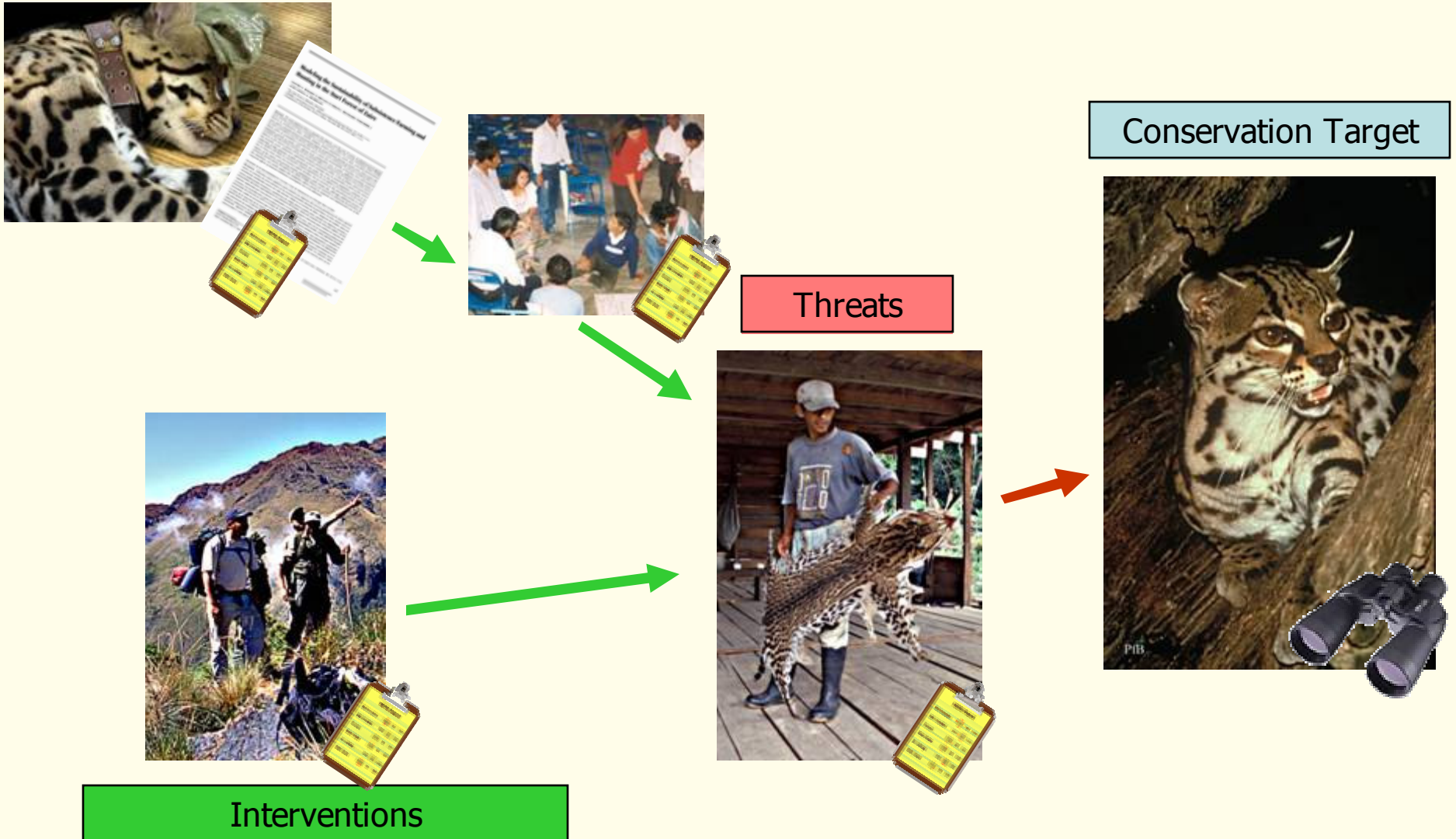




Monitoring along Causal Chains

Monitoring Framework

Conservation Target
Guanaco population in San Guillermo

Objective
Maintain current abundance of Guanaco in the landscape

Indicator
of Guanaco in landscape

Threat (Direct)
Habitat degradation due to unmanaged livestock grazing

Objective
No cattle grazing in the park by 2010
Maximum stocking rate of X cattle-days per year in provincial reserve by 2010

Threat (Indirect)
Lack of grazing regulations

Objective
Laws are in place to exclude grazing in the park and regulate stocking rates in the reserve by 2007

Intervention
Lobby government & livestock producers to promote policy reform

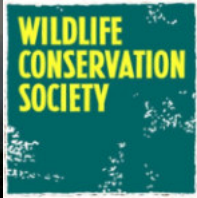
Objective
Key decision makers are identified and express desire to reform policy by 2007

Indicator
Statements of willingness to reform policy is on record

Objective

- What you want to achieve in terms of implementing interventions, reducing threats and enhancing the conservation status of targets
- Explicit benchmarks against which you can monitor progress
