- Landscapes and habitats

## Indicators

1. Number of conflicts (human-wildlife conflicts, land use conflicts)
2. % Budget allocation for implementation of the integrated land use plan
3. % uptake of integrated land use plans
4. Increase in biodiversity eg wildlife numbers
