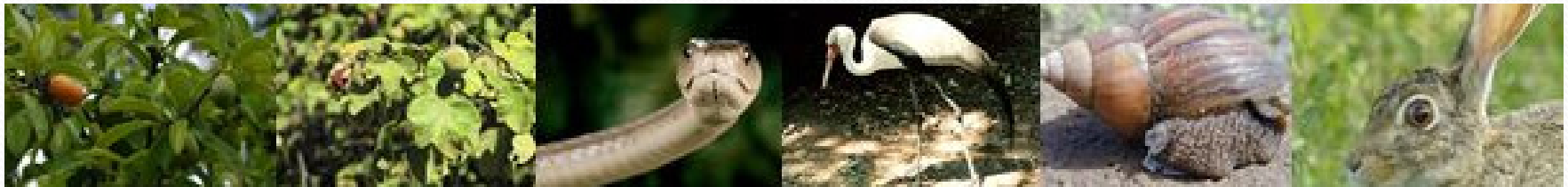

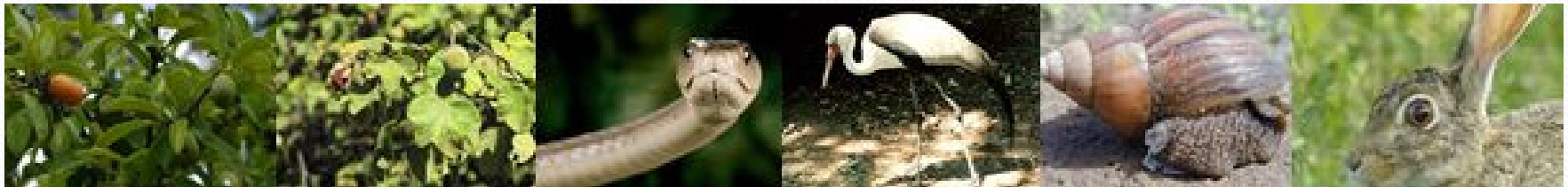

Updating Zimbabwe NBSAP

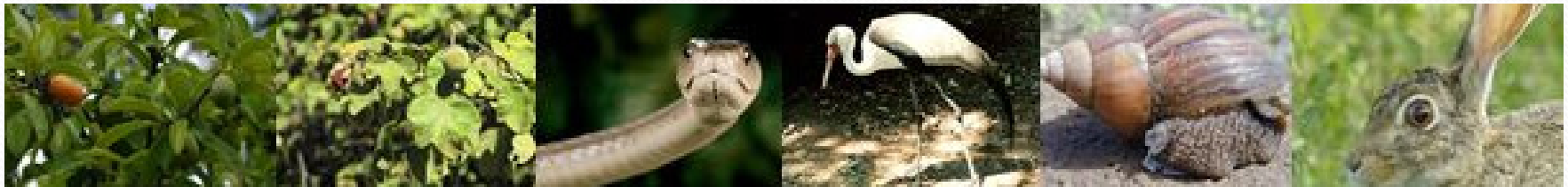
Participative Stocktaking exercise - this is part of the process of updating the NBSAP

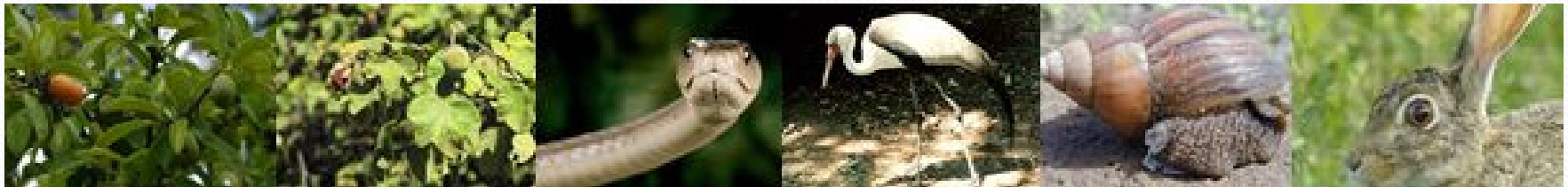

Progress Update

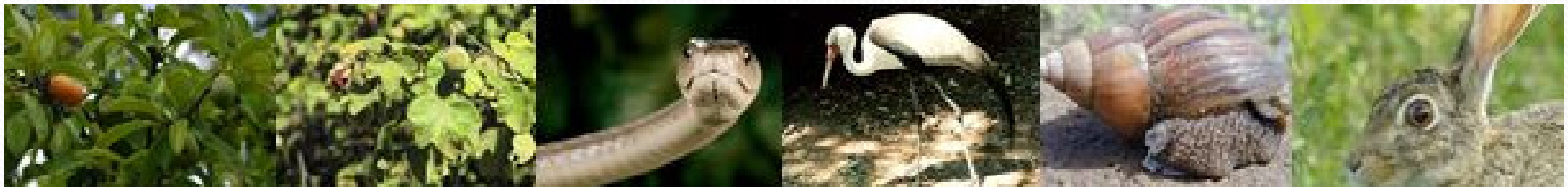
Consultative Stocktaking Workshop Held at Kadoma 6-8 March 2013

2. How well is the country doing on the biodiversity-people-sustainable development nexus



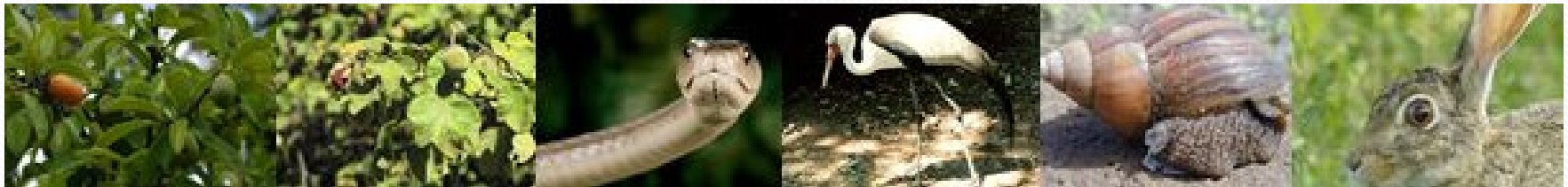
NBSAP Working Groups

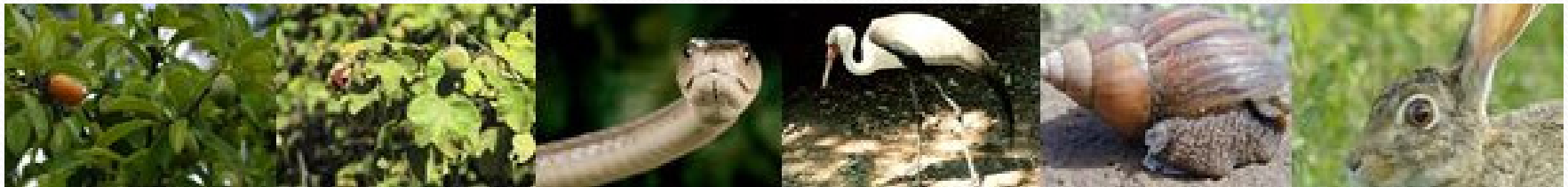
Preparing 5th National Report

- The review process for NBSAP will feed into the 5th National report
- The preparation of the 5th National report has started and a consultant has been identified



Development of a Clearing-house Mechanism

- Zimbabwe does not have a central clearing house for biodiversity information to share data either within or beyond the country's borders.
- A website developer has been identified and will commence work in July



‘Quick wins’

Zimbabwe identified “low hanging fruits” in which implementation could already start as the NBSAP is being developed.
